Introduction

Berkshire Record Office was established in 1948 to locate and preserve records relating to the county of Berkshire and its people, and to make them available for research to anyone who is interested in the county's past.

Using this Guide

The guide is arranged in alphabetical order of civil parish, and then according to the following abbreviations, which refer to the different kinds of record available:

PB	Punishment book
O	Other

The reference in brackets after each entry should be quoted if you would like to see that item. For more information about it please look up the reference in the appropriate catalogue.

Please note that the Record Office does not hold individual pupil records or exam results.

Note on Closure

Access to documents containing personal information is usually restricted; this is for a minimum of 30 years after the last entry in admission registers, log books and punishment books, 50 years for managers' minutes, and 30-50 years for correspondence, depending on content. If you wish to see a restricted item please ask a member of staff.
